Dear Families,

As we all get into the celebrations, it can also prove difficult for some families financially. If you are entitled to free school meals we continue to give out vouchers until March next year. In addition to the offer of FSM vouchers for eligible families, there is support available for families who are facing hardship and need support.

Anyone experiencing hardship may be able to receive support through the Norfolk Assistance Scheme (NAS), which may be able to provide support for food, fuel, clothes and other essential household items to families experiencing hardship. Wider support from a range of partners can then also be made available with NAS working alongside the Children's Services Community and Partnerships service.

Families may <u>get in touch with NAS via their dedicated website at Norfolk</u> <u>Assistance Scheme - Norfolk County Council</u>, which includes an online application form, or if they cannot access the internet, they can call <u>0344 800 8020</u>.
